Dear Riders & Judges,

Following the Dressage Forum at GHS a week or so ago, and in consultation with some of the stakeholders, SANEF is organising **South African Introduction to Grand Prix Clinic!**

We are thrilled to announce that we have been able to secure the services of **Jean Philippe Cambouives** who will run an Introduction to Grand Prix Clinic on the afternoon and evening of Tuesday the 27th of July. The aim of this clinic is to workshop the riding of the test; how to make the best of what we have, and how to judge Grand Prix at this level.

We are inviting all **riders** who feel that they may have, or could get a ride on, a horse that could possibly get through a Grand Prix test, even if there are some movements with which the horse struggles; and all riders who may not have a horse at this level but would benefit from attending this course as a non-mounted participant; and all **judges** who wish to learn more about judging Grand Prix in our developing circumstances to apply to attend.

Although this came from a GHS Dressage Forum and is to be held in Kyalami, it is a SANEF initiative in an attempt to raise the standard of South African Dressage. Riders and judges from all provinces are invited to apply to attend.

After the clinic, two Grand Prix Classes will be offered at the GHS Champs Warm-Up Show at Eaton Farm at the end of July - one on Saturday 31st July and one on Sunday 1st August. These classes will be offered free of entry fees. The plan is that these tests will be videoed by bio-kineticists from the High Performance Centre in Pretoria who will give a bio-kinetic analysis of each rider at a report back with Jean Philippe who will comment on the tests on the Tuesday evening (Tuesday 03 August) after the Eaton Farm Show. We are also lucky enough to have Kathy Amos Jacobs, an FEI Paralympic Judge who will judge the tests at Eaton Farm and will coach our judges while judging the Grand Prix classes.

This will be in preparation for the Grand Prix tests offered at GHS Champs where Mariette Witthages and some of our own judges will be judging!
