Lameness is defined as any change of the horse's gait. It can be caused by pain in the feet, the leg, the loins, the hip, the back, the shoulder, the neck or the withers.

The horse hurts somewhere and it is up to us to find out the cause of the pain and ensure that the horse receive proper treatment.
